# ATTENTION!



- All participants/students must be accompanied by adult supervisors during the Global Round event, with a minimum ratio of 1 supervisor for every 10 students.
- Students aged 12 and above can be supervised by their mentors, teachers, or supervisors assigned by their schools, institutions, or parents.
- Students under the age of 12 must be supervised exclusively by their parents or guardians.

## REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

- Once the results of the online round are announced, participants will be able to check their eligibility status for the Global Round.

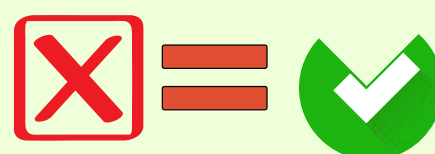
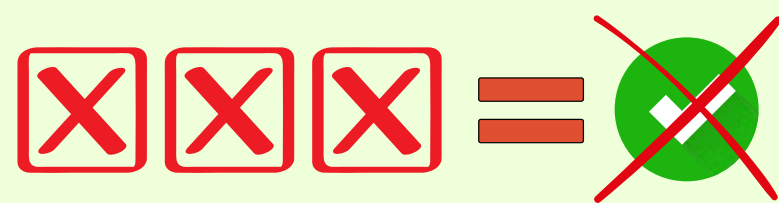

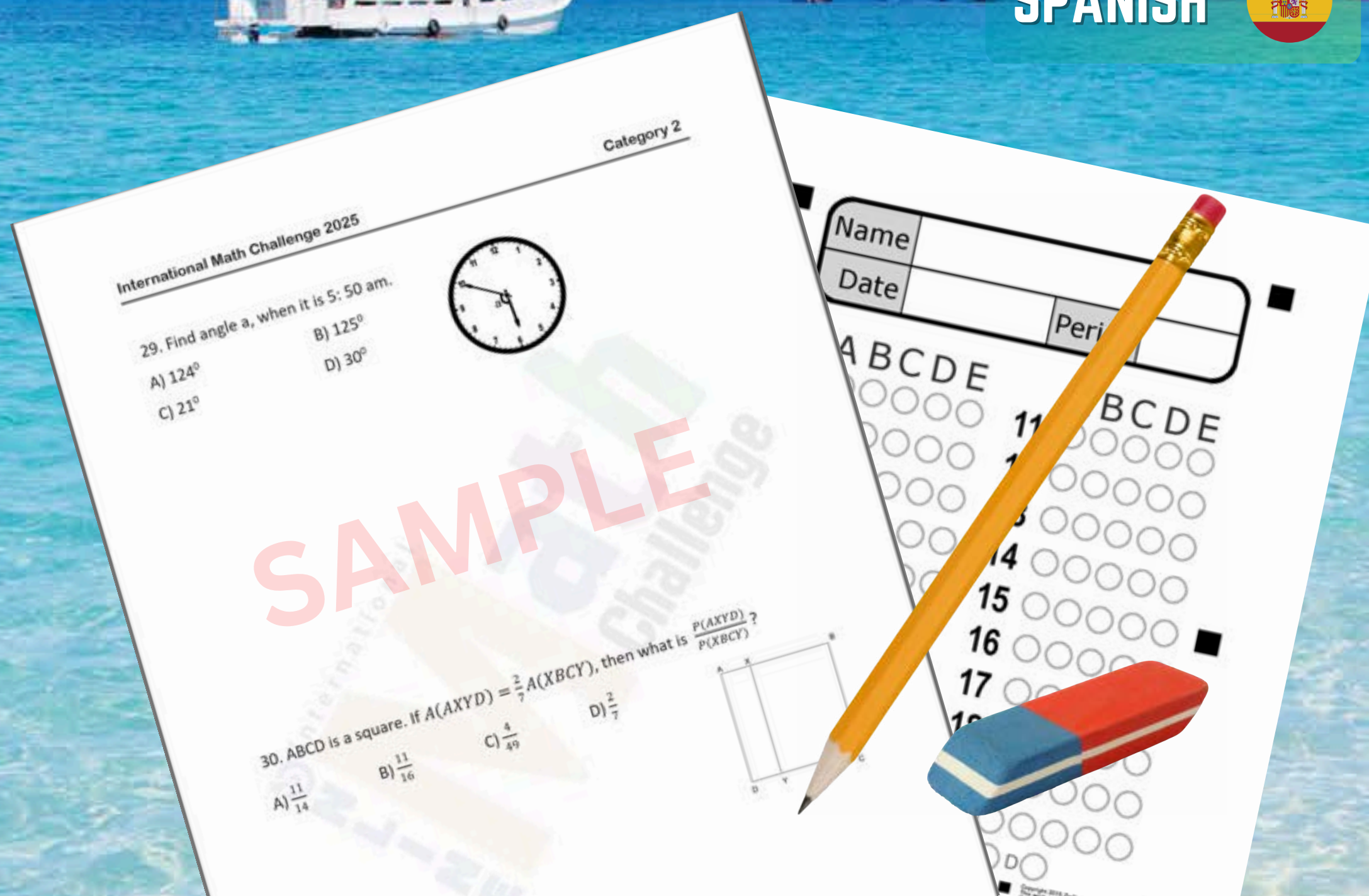
